Plastibec, one of the largest window-covering extrusion manufacturing company in North America, has been supplying the industry with decorative and award-winning products for vertical louvers, horizontal slats, and a variety of valance components since 1980.

The Canada-based company, which has distribution centers in Coral Springs, FL, and Irvine, CA, has made its mark in the industry with its Laserlite™, Trends™, Executive Valance™, SFT™, Sequoia™, and Cornice Valance brands.

“We understand and embrace window fashion,” says Angelo Sudano, vice president of marketing and product development. “We constantly strive for the best in design. True innovation, mastery of color, defining texture, and uncompromising quality—these always have been and always will be our hallmarks.”

Since March 2007, when the senior management bought the company, Plastibec has been expanded. The latest collection, Providence, is the first of several being developed. “The Providence Collection is our industry’s best yet,” Sudano says,

adding that Plastibec is poised to introduce four more lines and has another four on the drawing board. “It has beautiful style, texture and colors.”

Although Plastibec constantly sources the foreign market, 65 percent of its product is made in its 130,000-square-foot, ISO-certified factory in Boisbriand, QC, Canada. “With all the lead-paint scandals and all the bad news about the dangers of food and other products from China, our customers are asking for products that are made in North America,” Sudano says. “So we are using fewer imports, and what little we do import are only the basic products. Anything that is decorative and has high styling is made in Canada.”

Plastibec’s environmentally conscious practices also have attracted customers. As a green company, Plastibec puts a priority on recycling. Production scrap and mistakes are reused as packing materials and in the manufacturing of its recycled dust-cover valance profile. Louver end-cuts, instead of being discarded in landfills, are bought back from fabricators and distributors and reused, and the

factory has a loop system that reuses the same water for cooling the equipment.

With the new ownership in place and the Providence Collection launched, Plastibec will continue to build upon the long-term reputation that has made it an industry leader for nearly three decades. “The seven senior managers who own and run the company have more than 130 years of combined experience in the industry,” Sudano says. “As the premier PVC manufacturer for decorative products, we remain committed to quality, service and innovation, and we look forward to continuing long-term relationships with all of our customers.”
